

CRITERIA FOR NORTHWEST DISTRICT SCHOLARSHIPS
Available to Northwest District Students

The Northwest District has scholarship trust funds available to students who meet the following criteria, or a combination thereof:

- Attend a Wesleyan College/University, or any other seminary approved by The Wesleyan Church;
- Be a resident of the area now served by the Northwest District of The Wesleyan Church;
- Applications should be received prior to November 30, 2018 – and scholarship awards should be given thereafter for the ensuing school year;
- Maintain a grade point average of at least 2.5, based on a 1 to 4 grade point index;
- The Trustee shall lend further credence to financial need of the applicant when considering applications.
